



NaNoWriMo, Anyone?

November is National Novel Writing Month, also known as NaNoWriMo. If you're planning to participate this year, here are some tips that may help. Firstly, remember that you're only writing a rough draft. It doesn't have to be perfect because the goal is to get words onto paper. You can go back and edit later. Secondly, have an outline in front of you when you start. This way you'll have a better idea of what you want to write, and will end up keeping a lot of the work

you do during this month. And thirdly (perhaps most importantly), give yourself permission to fail. You don't have to win NaNoWriMo, but even if you write a little bit regularly, you'll have achieved a lot! Happy writing!


